IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court shall conduct a hearing on Friday, October 9, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. with respect to plaintiff's request that the defendants be ordered to immediately restore hosting services for Plaintiff's website, www.tollfreenumbers.com, and grant Plaintiff immediate and continuing access to all computer servers maintained, owned, controlled and/or leased by defendants and which store any versions of Plaintiff's website directory, source code and digital files so that Plaintiff may recover its intellectual property and restore its online business operations.

It is not expected that the defendant's will have time to file opposition in response to plaintiff's application in advance of the hearing, but they will be provided an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto.

A copy of this Order together with all the supporting paperwork of the plaintiff's shall be served upon the defendant's not later than 11:00 a.m. October 8, 2009.
